## **Sales and commissions**

If horse/pony is with us for training and is to be for sale, we strongly recommend a vet check including x-rays is done to confirm soundness. In our experience, it is beneficial all round to understand possible future soundness issues before time, and money is expended. This also ensures ongoing management of any issues can be thorough and effective, and that when the horse is ready to be sold it should pass a vet check.

Commission on sale is to be negotiated but an industry standard rate is 10%.

## **CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT FOR AGISTMENT**

### **PAYMENT**

The owner agrees:

To pay all fees and charges as agreed monthly/ weekly in advance as agreed. Prices below and attached price list.

\$44 per lunged day

In the event that agistment fees or other fees are unpaid, the owner grants a lien to Robali Stud over the horse so that the horse may not be removed from the Farm until outstanding fees are paid in full.

- In the event that agistment fees or other fees remain outstanding for a period of 30 days, the owner hereby irrevocably appoints Robali Stud to be the owner's attorney to sell the horse at public auction.
- Robali Stud will give a written notice to the owner of its intention to sell the horse at public auction after 7 days.
- On sale of the horse at public auction the proceeds of sale will be applied (after deduction of sales commissions and expenses associated with such sale) firstly against all agistment fees outstanding to the date of the sale and secondly against any other agistment fees outstanding by the owner in relation to any other horse that the owner has on agistment/training at Robali Stud and thirdly the balance, if any, to be paid to the owner.

Damage to horse or by horse:

- The owner is responsible for any damage caused by the horse whilst at agistment at Robali Stud and accepts all the risks of injury to the horse. It is recommended that the horse be insured with a reputable insurance company against injury to or loss of the horse or damage done by the horse to property including other animals.

Dispute Resolution:

- It is in everyone’s interest particularly that of the horse, to resolve all issues amicably. The owner and Robali Stud agree to negotiate, in good faith, any issue arising out of this contract.

Termination:

This contract will terminate at the end of the agreed period .....

or

- By either party giving the other party 48 hours notice in writing of termination.
- If notice of termination is given by either party, the owner agrees to make arrangements for the transportation of the horse at the owner’s expense. If the owner does not make arrangements for the transportation of the horse within 48 hours, Robali Stud may make arrangements for the transportation of the horse and any cost incurred will be an additional charge under this contract and recoverable under this contract. Disclaimer: Please note that while every reasonable attempt will be made to ensure the horse’s wellbeing, the owner leaves their horse here at their own risk. I,

## Sale of Horse

If it is agreed that the horse is to be sold on behalf of the owner by Robali Stud or Mckinnon Sport Horses, the owner agrees upon the sale of the horse, to pay 10% of the horses full sale price, ontop of agistment and training costs, to Robali Pastoral Trust or Mckinnon Sport Horses. This includes our time and expertise with the potential purchasers and photos and videos taken of the horse for advertising. Advertising is the owners own expense and will be added to the bill of the owner. We also strongly recommend that the horse to be sold has a pre purchase vet check done before beginning of training and advertising of sale.

All fees must be paid by the owner before the horse is to leave with its new owner.

If the horse is taken from the property and is no longer in training with Robali Stud/Mckinnon Sport Horses and it is sold with in 3 months of the date of departure or final services provided by Robali/Mckinnon Sport Horses, the above amount still applies. After 3 months this agreement will cease.

If it takes longer than 6 months to sell a horse, this agreement will cease and additional charges may apply.
